OUR AIM is to operate and develop safe and happy environments for children (aged from 0-19) with learning disabilities (with or without a physical disability) in West Berkshire and surrounding areas, to play, have fun, socially interact and develop. To offer them equal opportunities in play, sport and development through various activities and outings which will be age appropriate and enjoyable, equal to their peers without disabilities.

HOLIDAY PLAYSCHEMES

The West Berkshire Mencap Playscheme is a 1:1 caring environment that operates for 4 weeks in the summer holidays and day breaks at Easter and Christmas. This is for children and young adults from 3 to 19 years old with a learning disability. There are various entertainments and daily trips out to local venues. Based at the West Berkshire Mencap Centre. Times 9.30 to 3.30 excluding Wednesdays.

SAT FUN

Operates every four weeks at the centre, providing respite care for the parents or carers of children with a learning disability who are aged from 5 to 10 years. There is a morning session (for 10 children) 9.30 to 12.30 and an afternoon session (a further 10 children) from 1.30 to 4.30. There are lots of activities on site and occasional trips out.

SHARE OUR SATURDAYS

Provided by Social Services and managed by "West Berkshire Mencap Children's Services. Share our Saturdays are held at the Mencap Centre. This Saturday club provides essential respite for parents and carers of school aged children who have a learning disability.

Funky Thursdays (YOUTH CLUB)

As an extension of our After School Club activities, the Youth Club operates every Thursday (during term time) between 6.00 and 8.00. The age range is 12 to 19. The club will provide a varied fun program of activities, games and outings.

BUBBLE CLUB

A parent and toddler group for children 0-5 years old with a learning disability and their siblings. The Bubble Club is held on Wednesdays between 10-12 at the West Berkshire Mencap Centre.

ACTIVE ZONE

Our After School Clubs provide daily care for school aged children with a learning disability. Fun activities are available on site with a curriculum theme so the children can learn through play.
